The Department for Education has announced changes to relationships and sex education (RSE).

These changes came into effect from September 2020 (although have been delayed due to the COVID19 pandemic) and all schools will be required to comply with the updated requirements.

This means that we have reviewed our RSE curriculum and policy so we can be sure our RSE provision is appropriate for our pupils based on their:

- Age
- Physical and emotional maturity
- Religious and cultural backgrounds
- Special educational needs and/or disabilities
