

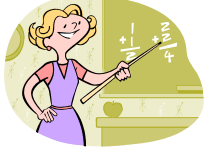

MATHS

This term, we will be concentrating on:

- Ratio
- Algebra
- Decimals
- Fractions, decimals and percentages
- Area, perimeter and volume
- Statistics

You can help your child by:

- Helping your child to learn maths target facts - 5-10 minutes every day is ideal. Maths Targets are times tables and divide. Each child has their own target which you will find in their homework book.
- Practise counting in different steps e.g. counting forwards and backwards in 10s, 100s, 50s, 4s and 8s.
- Sats Qs Hwk Sats questions will be sent home each week- we will go through the answers together on Tuesday.
